Telephone Hotline	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Receive referrals from detainees, their families, and concerned citizens • Provide information on migrant's rights • Call and write letters to authorities on behalf of the migrants • Refer migrants to other human rights organizations 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Participate in a basic training and meetings every two months • Knowledge of English and other relevant languages • E-mail address and computer competency 	4 hours a week in the AM or PM for at least a year.
Prison Visits to Migrants and Trafficking Victims	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Observe, document, and represent migrants in prison tribunals • Meet with individuals to speak about their cases, concerns they may have, or to give them information • Distribute information and rights sheets • Write and submit report of visit to the HMW 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Means of transportation • Additional languages a bonus • Patience, good listening skills, sensitivity, ability to create a connection with the detainee • Access to E-mail and a printer • Russian speaker for trafficking victims 	Every week or every other week for a full day according to prior arrangement
Providing Individual Assistance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Upon release from detention, accompany migrants to a variety of government offices, banks, embassies, etc... • Provide support to a single parent family or other family in need by helping them run errands, babysitting, offering advice, etc... 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Assertiveness, patience, and perseverance • Availability 	As needed

Media	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Writing Press – Releases • Collecting testimonies from Migrant Workers in order to have them published • Being in contact with the media • Collecting and filing media reports 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Good writing skills in Hebrew and/or English • Knowledge of the media • Stubbornness • Good personal skills • Willingness to learn the issue 	As needed
